

District V High School Honor Band

Congratulations on being selected to the District V Honor Bands. Included in this letter are specific times, locations, and responsibilities that are expected of you as a member of the Honor Bands.

As a member of the honor band, you are excused from school to participate; therefore, all school rules involving discipline/behavior (excluding tardiness, listed below) will apply to all rehearsals and performances. In addition, any student in violation of the following rules; (1) fighting, (2) possession or under the influence of drugs or alcohol or tobacco (3) direct disrespect to a clinician or authority, (4) disruptive actions on stage; will be dismissed from the honor band immediately & will have their school placed on probation for a one year period. The student in violation will not be allowed to participate in any District V activities for the following year. If probation is broken, the student's school will lose its right to participate in any District V Band Directors' Association functions for a one-year period.

You and your parents are required to sign the Honor Band Pledge at the bottom of this letter. Again, congratulations on you selection, and we look forward to having you as a member of the District V Honor Bands.

Please be early for all rehearsals and have all proper equipment. Any additional information needed will be provided at the rehearsal.

Unexcused tardiness will result in the student being moved to the end of their section. Two unexcused tardies will result in expulsion from the honor band. Absences, which have been excused prior to the absence, will result in removal from the Honor Bands with a refund of fees, and it will be cleared for the student to try out the following year. Unexcused absences will result in dismissal from the Honor Bands with a loss of fees and the expulsion from the following year's Honor Band auditions.

The Student

1. Attendance

- a. any missed rehearsal is an absence
- b. Absences may only be excused prior to the absence and must be approved by the District President, or in his absence, 1st V.P. or the 2nd V.P.
- c. **Excused Absences** will result in removal from the honor band with a refund of fees. The student will be cleared to audition the following year.
- d. **Unexcused Absences** will result in removal from the honor band with no refund, and exclusion from the following year’s honor band auditions.
- e. **Tardies** are tardies; however, the District V Band Association’s President will make all decisions regarding **Excused** and **Unexcused** tardies.

Unexcused Tardy #1: move to the end of your part (ex. 1st chair clarinet moves to last chair first part);

Unexcused Tardy #2: removed from band. There will be NO differentiation between rehearsals and a performance.

2. **Behavior:**

- a. Students are expected to behave properly:
 - i. No talking in rehearsal
 - ii. No Drinks, Candy, Gum, etc. in Rehearsal
 - iii. No Unnecessary Disruptions or Distractions (i.e., playing posture, noises, unnecessary movement, hats, sunglasses, etc.)
- b. The band chairman will appropriately discipline students choosing to misbehave. Continued misbehaving will result in stronger discipline, including possible removal from Honor Band.

3. **Dress Code:**

- a. Boys will wear a long-sleeved button down dress shirt with a tie, appropriate slacks or other dress pants with a belt or suspenders, proper dress shoes and crew length socks (no ankle or no-show socks). A nice suit is appropriate, but a suit jacket/blazer is not required.
- b. Girls will wear a dress (no low-cut necks or low-cut “backless” dresses), a long skirt and blouse, or a nice pant suit and proper dress shoes. Dresses and shirts must cover the knees while seated. Shoulders must be covered (no “spaghetti straps” or halter tops).

Prohibited items: T-shirts, polo shirts, jeans of any color, flip=flops, sneakers, athletic shoes, slippers.
